

An amendment to the Missouri Constitution has been proposed which will allow contributors to "non-profit" Organizations to receive tax credits.
For example: (Catholic Charities, Red Cross, Salvation Army, St. James Catholic Church)

The tax credits will be 50% of all donations/ tithes to non-profits made in Missouri.

Please be clear, these tax credits are in addition to existing federal and state allowable deductions.

To get this amendment on the Nov. 4th, 2008 ballot we need all registered voters to sign the petitions on the tables in the narthex.

The Knights of Columbus coordinating this effort must witness your signature.

Anyone missing today's sign-up will have the opportunity to sign after next weekend's Masses.

BULLET POINTS

- Proposed Amendment to MO. Constitution
- You must be a registered voter in Mo.
- Tax credits will consist of 50% of all contributions to "Non-Profits" for example: Catholic Charities, Red Cross, Salvation Army, as well as St. James Catholic Church in the state of Mo.
- Tax Credits are in addition to federal and state deductions currently allowed.
- Signature must be witnessed.
