Fall Sports REGISTRATION

Registration for football, volleyball and cross country will begin on June 1st and will close on August 9th

ALL REGISTRATIONS AND PAYMENTS WILL BE ON THE INTERNET

The parochial league website is <u>WWW.PLKC.ORG</u>. Click on REGISTRATION and follow the prompts.

FYI 1st and 2nd grade flag football and all volleyball teams will select St. James as the school when registering online. Children registering for 3rd-4th grade flag football, all tackle football teams and cross country will select Northland Catholic as the school when registering.

Football Registration for the 2013-2014 school year is for boys in the 1st through 8th grades.

The teams will participate in the Kansas City Parochial League. The KCPL practices officially begin in early August (usually the week before school starts) and games are played September through November.

Flag football is offered for 1st/2nd grade and 3rd/4th grade. The registration fee is \$75.

Tackle football is offered for 3rd/4th grade, 5th/6th grade, and 7th/8th grade. The registration fee is \$175. St. James will have our own 1st and 2nd grade flag football team and will combine with the Northland Catholic Warriors for 3rd and 4th grade flag and 3rd/4th, 5th/6th, and 7th/8th tackle teams.

<u>Cross Country Registration</u> for the 2013-2014 school year is for boys and girls in the 3rd-8th grades. We will be combining with St. Andrew, St. Patrick, and St. Gabriel to form a Northland Catholic Cross Country team.

The team will participate in the Kansas City Parochial League. The KCPL cross country practices officially begin in August and there will be 3 invitational meets (one location is O'Hara – the others are TBD) and a City Meet which will be at Longview Lake. All meets will be scheduled on Monday evenings in September and October.

Meets will not interfere with PLKC volleyball or football games.

The 3rd/4th grade distance will be ³/₄ mile, the 5th/6th grade will be 1.2 miles and the 7th/8th grade will be 2 miles.

The registration fee will be \$35.

Volleyball Registration for the 2013-2014 school year is for girls in the 4th-8th grade. The registration fee is \$75. Additional info can be found on the school website.
